R Robert J. de Boer holds an M.Sc. degree in Ecology (1968) from the State University of Utrecht. He gained ample experience as a vegetation and soil scientist, holding posts at the universities of Nimeguen and Wageningen, and in the International Biological Programme (IBP) in England. Over the course of his career, having taken an early interest in earth observation, he increasingly applied himself to remote sensing techniques - including atmospheric research, and now commercially exploits remote sensing on a global scale.

His management experience goes back to 1975, when he became managing director of a non-profit environmental organization. 1987 Saw his starting a private aerospace survey and remote sensing company. Rapid developments in the field of microwave remote sensing led him to the establishment of WAGENINGEN RADAR SURVEYS, aiming at state-of-the-art operating radar remote sensing techniques. The GEOSAT INTERNATIONAL GROUP OF COMPANIES was launched, covering a broad field of remote sensing, GIS and monitoring applications on the basis of close cooperation and sharing expertise, worldwide. Recent professional missions for management and consultancy purposes led Robert de Boer to Andhra Pradesh (India), Botswana, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, China, Côte d'Ivoire, Guyana (South America), Indonesia, Palestinian Territories, Tunisia, and Zimbabwe. Projects have been carried out by the aforesaid companies in many countries. Consultancies were carried out for the European Union, United Nations, The World Bank and the Government of The Netherlands.
